


CHASING ICE

2014 OHIO TOUR

Chasing Ice is an Academy Award-Nominated documentary film that captures visual evidence of climate change through the use of time-lapse photography. The film premiered at the Sundance Film Festival, has broadcasted in 172 countries, and has won nearly 40 awards from festivals around the world. The film has also screened at the United Nations, before Congress, and at the White House.

In partnership with **National Geographic**, *Chasing Ice* recently launched the **Chasing Ice Ohio Tour 2014**; an initiative to share the story and visual evidence of our changing climate to central Ohio residents through FREE screening events. Film screenings are followed by a Q&A discussion led by **Director/Producer, Jeff Orlowski**, and/or the Chasing Ice team, with the hope to connect the dots between changes we are seeing worldwide and the impact that these changes are having on central Ohio.

The Chasing Ice Ohio Tour

The Chasing Ice Team, including Director/Producer Jeff Orlowski, is on the ground in the central Ohio region with the goal to share the visual story of our shifting climate through the use of the film *Chasing Ice*. The team is currently looking for host venues and organizations to support FREE screening events for local communities, high schools, universities, churches, organizations, and corporations throughout March and April 2014.

Our screening program includes three main elements:

- **Screening of the Film:** The Chasing Ice Team can be on location to screen the film, lead discussions, and facilitate question and answer sessions. Our interactive program can be shared with youth groups, organizations and church communities. We are able to host a variety of programs with several options for different lengths of the film and discussion periods. All programs can be adjusted to fit your needs and scheduling.

Film-length Options: 6 minutes, 11 minutes, 23 minutes, 36 minutes, 75 minutes

- **Call to Action:** The Tour offers new tools that allow people to quickly and easily share their views on climate change with their friends and community, and specifically their local representatives. Through this program, people will come together to learn how to individually and collectively take action in their community. As climate change is an issue that requires political support to make significant progress, our main call to action is to encourage the public to encourage their political leaders to Change Their Legacy.
- **Youth Ambassador Program:** We believe youth have a powerful voice within their communities and around the world. The Chasing Ice Youth Ambassador Program is a creative initiative that empowers youth to be leaders in their community. Through the use of technology and multi-media tools, students will come together to share and exchange innovative ideas for a sustainable future. The leadership program will allow youth to work together and capture their friends' stories through the social media platforms they already use: Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter.

Frequently Asked Questions:

What are our responsibilities as the host?

- 1) A room for the screening
- 2) Seats for folks who come
- 3) Publicity within your venue or school to encourage folks to attend

Are there any costs involved in hosting a screening? No!

Do we have to sign a contract? No!

Are there any expectations on hosts beyond the actual screening event? No!

Can we review the film? Yes! Chasing Ice [6-minute preview link](#).

Can we review any materials that would be handed out? Yes! Just let us know.

What will the “Call to Action” include?

The “Call to Action” is short, simple, and completely voluntary. It will center on possible next steps such as sharing the film with family and friends, posting about it on Facebook, Twitter and Instagram, or contacting your local Congressman to express support for climate action.

How political is this?

The film was created to be politically neutral in its nature, thus the screening events focus on visible evidence and impacts of climate change and what that means for us. As with most issues, there are political ramifications, but nowhere is a specific legislative solution prescribed and any discussion will be held in a careful non-partisan way. Our objective is to fully support our political leaders, not attack them. We are encouraging the public to reach out to a local Congressman in Ohio, to participate in the democratic process and to share their thoughts with their representatives.

Who will be leading the discussion/Q&A?

Director/Producer Jeff Orlowski and/or the Chasing Ice team can be requested to attend an event and to lead discussion and answer any questions after the screening of the film. We are providing FREE DVDs to central Ohio residence and encourage them to host their own events at homes, churches, corporations or community centers, with or without our team!

What about those who have different perspectives on climate change?

All people and perspectives are welcome. Everyone is not expected to have the same perspective on climate change (or the film!) and screenings will be run with grace and charity to make sure everyone is welcomed and respected.
